I am writing to express my deep concern on the captioned matter.

According to the Steering Committee on Population Report

"From 2001 to 2010, a total of 466 430 new arrivals from the Mainland have settled in Hong Kong for family reunion through the OWP Scheme and its ratio to the overall population increase of the period was 119.4%<sup>26</sup>. As pointed out in Chapter II, it is a major source of population replenishment for Hong Kong in terms of quantity, second to births. In 2011, the inflow of OWP holders amounted to 43 379, representing a daily average of 119."

As mentioned by CS, HK is not allowed to take control on the OWP scheme because of constitutional issue. However, It is very CLEAR that the social burden created by them in housing, welfare, medical care and education is enormous. Who pay for the bill? Taxpayers of course. We cannot sit back and do nothing. The administration should take the initiative for censoring the "best" people. HK is not a black hole for UNLIMITED arrivals.
